OVERVIEW:

- For this afternoon to the evening hours, an enhanced risk (level 3) has been forecasted for Southaven and south towards Tupelo. Damaging winds up to 70mph with hail up to golf ball size and tornadoes are likely. A slight risk (level 2) for Cleveland, south towards Yazoo City and east towards Columbus. Severe storms with damaging wind gusts, quarter size hail, and tornadoes are possible. A marginal risk (level 1) for Vicksburg and Philadelphia. Isolated severe storms with damaging wind gusts.
- For Thursday night, enhanced risk (level 3) is predicted for the central region Hamburg southeastern to Laurel. Severe storms with damaging winds up to 75 MPH, large hail up to golf ball size, and tornadoes can't be ruled out. Slight risk (level 2) is predicted for the areas Greenville over to Columbus and Natchez over to Hattiesburg. Severe storms with damaging winds up to 60 mph, quarter to golf ball size hail are possible, and tornadoes can't be ruled out. A marginal risk (level 1) for the northern/central region Cleveland to the eastern state line. Isolated severe storms with damaging wind gusts and quarter size hail are possible.






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


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
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SPC Severe Wind Outlook Wednesday



SPC Tornado Outlook Wednesday








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
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SPC Severe Hail Outlook Wednesday




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

WPC Excessive Rainfall Wednesday






